# 96<sup>th</sup> Highlanders – 2020/21 Fees Breakdown

### **Annual Membership Fee to the organization**

Membership fees are \$100 per year. Only one membership is required per family.

## Instructional Fees for 96th participants

The Instructional Fee for 2020-21 is \$1000 for all returning students and \$675 for beginner students.

# **Payment Options**

- 1. Lump sum payment of \$1000 for the year (or \$675 for new students), due September 21, 2020.
- 2. Quarterly payments of \$250 (or \$168.75 for new students), each due Sept 21<sup>st</sup> 2020, Dec 1<sup>st</sup> 2020, Feb 1<sup>st</sup> 2021, and April 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 (new students first payment due Oct 1<sup>st</sup> 2020)
- 3. Monthly payments First Payment of \$100 is due Sept 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020 the remainder may be submitted in the form of postdated cheques dated the first of each month, from Oct 2020 to June 2021.

\*Note: New students are not required to pay instructional fees for the month of September and are only required to submit nine postdated cheques in the amount of \$75 each for the months of Oct 2020 to June 2021

#### **Methods of Payment**

Payment of fees may be made one of three ways:

1. Post-dated cheques: Please date the first cheque Sept 21, 2020 and following that, the first of each month, Oct 2020-June 2021. Cheques may be made out to "96<sup>th</sup> Highlanders" and, this year, for a contactless submission, please mail cheques to the following address:

- E-transfer: Payment of the Annual membership fee and the Sept payment only made be made via e-transfer this year. Please make e-transfer payments to <u>96thtreasurer@gmail.com</u> Post-dated cheques will be required for all remaining payments.
- 3. Fundraising Credits: To use this payment method, please complete the 'Request for Use of Fundraising Credits Form' and submit before Sept 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020. \*Please note: You must have already earned enough credits in your family's account in order to be eligible to use this payment method.

### Fundraising fee - \$ 1000.00 per family

The 96<sup>th</sup> Highlanders normally require a \$1000 fundraising fee per family, per year, payable in 4 post-dated cheques. \*Note: These cheques are only cashed if the student/family fails to fulfill their volunteer requirement at each of the four band fundraising events (Bottle Drive, Christmas Concert/Steak Night, Burns Supper, Scotch Tasting). In our response to Covid19, we will not be collecting any fundraising cheques, as our fundraisers are currently on hold due to the pandemic. However, please be advised that should health guidelines allow larger groups to gather once again, one or more of our fundraisers may still be planned and take place this year, and, in this case, either volunteer requirements, or cheques in lieu of, will once again be required. Stay tuned – information on this will be shared as it becomes available.

### Performance Trip - PEI and New Brunswick, July 2021

The hope is that the trip to PEI/New Brunswick, which had been scheduled for July 2020 but had to be cancelled due to Covid19, can be rescheduled and take place in July 2021. The fee would once again be \$1000.00 per participant, with remaining trip costs to be offset by band fundraising initiatives, should we be able to hold any fundraisers in the months prior to the trip.
