

96th Highlanders – 2021/22 Fees Breakdown

Annual Membership Fee to the organization

Membership fees are \$100 per year. Only one membership is required per family.

Annual Instructional Fees for 96th participants

The Instructional Fee for 2021-22 is \$900 for all returning students and \$675 for beginner students.

Payment Options

1. Lump sum payment of \$900 for the year (or \$675 for new students), due September 27, 2021.
2. Quarterly payments of \$225 (or \$168.75 for new students), each due Sept 27th 2021, Dec 1st 2021, Feb 1st 2022, and April 1st 2022
3. Monthly payments - First Payment of \$100 is due Sept 27th, 2021 – the remainder may be submitted monthly by e-transfer or in the form of postdated cheques dated the first of each month, from Nov 2021 to June 2022.

Methods of Payment

Payment of fees may be made one of three ways:

1. Post-dated cheques: Please date the first cheque Sept 27th, 2021 and following that, the first of each month, Nov 2021-June 2022. Cheques may be made out to “96th Highlanders” and brought to this year’s Band Registration Night at 7:00pm on September 27th, 2021 at Knox United Church (838 Spadina Crescent East).
2. E-transfer: Payment of the Annual membership fee and Instructional fees may be made via e-transfer. Please make e-transfer payments to 96thtreasurer@gmail.com
3. Fundraising Credits: To use this payment method, please complete the [‘Request for Use of Fundraising Credits Form’](#) on or before Sept 27th, 2021. ***Please note:** You must have already earned enough credits in your family’s account in order to be eligible to use this payment method.

Fundraising fee:

*For 2021, no fundraising cheques will be collected

In normal times, the 96th Highlanders requires a \$1000 fundraising fee per family, per year, payable in 4 post-dated cheques. **These cheques are only cashed if the student/family fails to fulfill their volunteer requirement at each of the four band fundraising events** (Fall Bottle Drive; Christmas Concert/Steak Night; Burns Supper; Scotch Tasting). **In our response to Covid19, we will not be collecting any fundraising cheques for the 2021-22 year**, as our fundraisers may or may not take place again this year.

Please be advised that should health guidelines allow for our events to safely happen, one or more of our four main fundraisers may still be planned and take place this year. In the event that we are able to safely hold any of our fundraisers, volunteers from each band family will be required to help make these events a success.
