## **96th Highlanders – 2024/25 Fees Breakdown**

### **Annual Membership Fee to the Organization**

Membership fees are \$25 per year. Only one membership is required per family. The membership fee is due at the beginning of the year and can be paid by cheque, cash or e-transfer.

### **Annual Instructional Fees for 96th Participants**

First year students will not be required to pay bingo deposits or work bingos. The Instructional Fee for 2024-2025 has been waived for all students.

### **Bingo Deposits (returning students only)**

Returning students are required to provide a deposit of \$400 (or 2 x \$200) which will be returned if they work four (4) bingos.

Students joining after the beginning of the year will pay prorated deposits.

1. One payment of \$400 due at the first lesson.
2. One payment of \$200 due at the first lesson in September. If fewer than two(2) bingos have been worked between September and February, a further deposit will be required at the beginning of February to make up the difference.
3. The Deposits will be returned at a rate of \$100 per bingo worked. There will be a return in early February and another at the end of June.

### **Methods of Payment**

Payment of fees and deposits may be made in the following ways:

1. Cheque: Cheques may be made out to “96<sup>th</sup> Highlanders” and brought to the first lesson.
2. E-transfer: Payment of the Annual membership fee and Deposit fees may be made via e-transfer. Please make e-transfer payments to [96thtreasurer@gmail.com](mailto:96thtreasurer@gmail.com)
